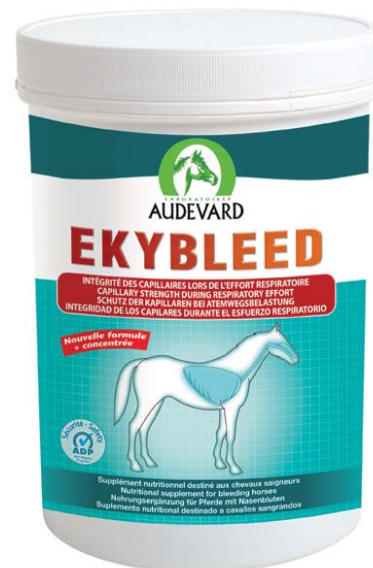

Sweet clover: <i>Melilotus officinalis</i>	200g	Dandelion: <i>Taraxacum officinale</i>	100g	Rosemary: <i>Rosmarinus officinalis</i>	100g

### Directions for use

1 level scoop (35g) per day for two weeks.  
EKYBLEED can be administered all year long. Ask your vet for advice.
